Unable to Continue:

Should the appointed official(s) be unable to continue, the remaining systems shall be used:

- In the 2R, 2L system, if an official is unable to continue, an approved divisional system shall be used.
- In the 2R, 1L system, if an official is unable to continue, a 1R, 1L system shall be used.
- In the 1R, 2L system, if an official is unable to continue, a 1R, 1L system shall be used.
- In any ACHA game, no game may be played with one official.
